Press Release: India–Mexico Pharmaceutical Sector Meet - Advancing Cooperation in Pharmaceuticals and Healthcare

01 September 2026, Mexico City

The Embassy of India in Mexico City hosted a networking event with representatives of the Indian and Mexican pharmaceutical and healthcare sectors, with participation from the Government of Mexico City, including the Secretaria de Desarrollo Economico (Secretariat of Economic Development, SEDECO) and the Agencia de Inversiones de la Ciudad de Mexico (Mexico City Investment Agency, inCDMX). The meeting focused on strengthening cooperation and business linkages in pharmaceuticals and healthcare.

2. The engagement brought together representatives of Mexicip S.A. de C.V. (Cipla Ltd.), Enzene Biosciences (represented by senior executives from India and the United States), Farmaceutica Zeux, Laboratorios Torrent, Saya Biologics, Noxgen Biotech, Micro Pharmaceuticals, Zydus Farmaceutica, Sun Pharma Mexico, Accord Farma, Caritas Pharma, Juvencia Lifesciences and Avant Sante Research Center, along with other stakeholders from the sector.

Discussions highlighted the strength and global competitiveness of India's pharmaceutical sector, including its capabilities in manufacturing and supplying quality, affordable and accessible medicines. Participants exchanged views on strengthening India–Mexico cooperation through industry collaboration, investment, innovation and research and development. Opportunities for greater engagement between established Indian pharmaceutical companies in Mexico and Mexican stakeholders were also explored.

4. The discussions highlighted opportunities to leverage the strengths of both countries in pharmaceuticals, biotechnology and healthcare, with a focus on innovation and affordable healthcare. The participation of SEDECO and inCDMX provided an opportunity to discuss avenues for further strengthening bilateral cooperation and investment in the life sciences sectors.

5. The occasion also provided an opportunity to showcase products from various Indian States under the One District One Product (ODOP) initiative to the participating companies and stakeholders, highlighting India's diverse manufacturing and entrepreneurial capabilities.
