Advisory for Indian citizens traveling to Mexico without proper travel documents

Recently, there has been a significant increase in the number of Indian citizens falling prey to unscrupulous agents and traffickers promising them safe passage into Mexico without proper documentation. In a number of cases, the Indian citizens end up being kidnapped, taken hostage, assaulted with physical and mental torture, as well as severely harassed for huge ransom by human traffickers and criminal networks.

In a number of cases, the Embassy had to seek intervention of the Mexican police and other law enforcement agencies for search and rescue operation, and with their cooperation, was able to get them released. However, the success of rescue and relief is not guaranteed in every case despite the best efforts by the Embassy of India in Mexico and the Mexican law enforcement agencies.

Indian citizens are strongly warned not to fall prey to agents who promise safe travel to Mexico without proper visa, passports other requisite documentation.

All Indian citizens are advised to undertake travel only through legal and official immigration channels.
